- 1. First week play will extablish handicaps. Handicaps are updated each week and will be posted on the GJGA website along with the week's results.
- 2. All players will play from Blue Tees, except seniors (65+) who may play from Red Tees if they prefer.
- 3. Scoring: 2 points are available per match. Points are awarded based on lowest net score. High handicap players from each team will compete for 1 point, and low handicaps for the other point. In the event of a tie, a half point will be awarded to each team.
- 4. Please take a picture of the scorecard at the end of the round and text it to Greg at 567-241-3746
- 5. If you miss a round, you may either find a sub or make up the round. For make-ups, the scorecard must be submitted by the Sunday evening following league play. If only one player from a team submits a scorecard for the round, that score will stand against both the low and high handicap players' scores from the opposing team. In the event that both players from a team miss a round, both points will be awarded to the opposing team.
- 6. For handicapping purposes, a max score of Par+3 will be used for each hole. Any score submitted that's above this score will be adjusted down to Par+3. This only affects the handicap calculation. Actual gross scores will be used to determine net score for the purpose of assigning points for the matches.
